Updated monthly, as of April 2009, PsycBooks features over 1,702 books and more than 26,000 chapters: 768 APA books, including 100 out-of-print books with copyright dates from 1950 - 2002; 934 classic, archival resources in psychology; and the exclusive electronic release of more than 1,500 entries from the APA/Oxford University Press Encyclopedia of Psychology.
