EMBASE Classic is an essential abstract and index backfile which enables biomedical researchers to review critical research from 1947 to 1973.

Drawn from approximately 3,400 international titles, EMBASE Classic indexes more than 1.8 million records from the biomedical and pharmacological literature covering 27 years of biomedical research and drawn from 43 Excerpta Medica abstract print journals.
