Comprehensive Systematic Review Training Course
Monday 28 April – 2 May 2014

This 5-day short course is designed to prepare researchers and clinicians to develop, conduct and report comprehensive systematic reviews of evidence using systematic review software. Participants should have an existing knowledge of research methodology and sound critical appraisal skills.

The course is delivered by members of the Joanna Briggs Institute Collaborating Centre for Evidence Based Practice at the University of West London and includes the following modules:

- An introduction to evidence based healthcare and the systematic review of evidence (1 day)
- The systematic review of evidence generated by quantitative research (2 days)
- The systematic review of evidence generated by qualitative research, narrative and text (2 days)

Assessment is integrated into the 5-day course and takes the form of online tests and in-class presentations. Participants who successfully complete the course are certified by the Joanna Briggs Institute as competent in the systematic review process.
