Database Archives

BIOSIS® Archive

With abstracts written by Nobel Prize winners and other notable scientists, this database contains the entire print collection of *Biological Abstracts* journals published between 1926 and 1968, prior to the series moving online in 1969. It includes 3.5 million records from hard-to-find journals, books, patents, conference reports, and other publications.

Zoological Record® Archive

More than 1.5 million bibliographic records from the first 106 print volumes of *Zoological Record* published between 1864 and 1977. Records have been assembled and edited by giants in the field of animal biology and biodiversity, including Charles Darwin and Albert Gunther. Use current Zoological Record thesaurus terms to uncover every animal name and description included in the print volumes during this period.

CAB Abstracts Archive

Electronic access to more than 1.8 million records of agricultural science, veterinary medicine, nutrition and natural resources journals published in print from 1910-1972. Topics include biodiversity, environmental pollution, natural resources, plant and animal breeding, and more. Fully searchable with CAB Abstracts, it has been re-indexed with modern search terms.

Global Health Archive

Covering tropical and communicable diseases, economic development, nutrition, entomology, and mycology, this public health database contains over 800,000 bibliographic records of literature published 1910-1973. Fully searchable with the current Global Health file on OvidSP.

Embase® Classic

Integrated access to more than 1.8 million records drawn from 43 *Excerpta Medica Abstract* biomedical and pharmacological journals published between 1947 and 1973. You'll uncover pioneering literature in cancer, drug development, and other key specialty areas. And take advantage of Ovid's advanced implementation of Elsevier's Emtree thesaurus (also available in the current Embase databases).

Inspec Archive

Access to the entire collection of *Science Abstracts* journals published between 1898 and 1968—that means over 873,000 records, 140,000 pages of international scientific literature in physics, engineering, and materials science. Use the current Inspec thesaurus terms and classification codes.
