ACP Journal Club - American College of Physicians

The ACP Journal Club collection provides you with two leading journals: *ACP Journal Club*, a publication of the American College of Physicians, and *Evidence-Based Medicine*, a joint publication with the British Medical Journal Publishing Group.

Definitive Controlled Trials - Cochrane Collaboration

The largest register of its kind, this database contains over 580,000 bibliographic references to definite randomized controlled trials or controlled clinical trials. It also contains relevant records from MEDLINE®, EMBASE®, and other bibliographic databases, as well as information on unpublished trials.

A bibliography of more than 11,000 references to controlled trials in journal articles, book chapters, conference proceedings and reports, and other publications of methodologies used in health studies. Content is constantly being expanded via an extensive hand-searching program and the development of a series of search strategies in MEDLINE and EMBASE.
