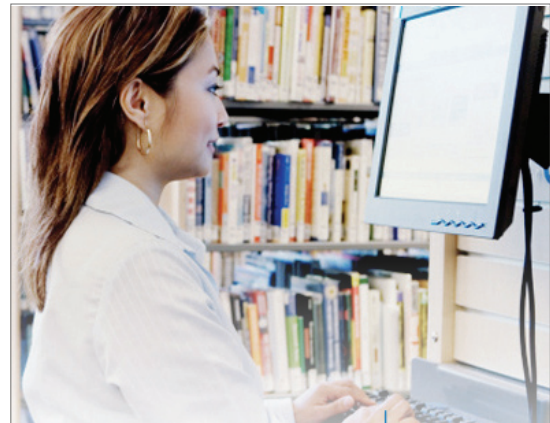

The needs of the market constantly inform all of our product releases. OvidSP was designed and developed based directly on extensive interviews with information managers and end users. That's why we're excited to announce that in early April, we're implementing the following new features (Stay tuned for more details on the exact timing of the release).

MARC records

Customers will be able to download MARC records for all books and journals that they subscribe to on OvidSP.

- **Non-English Language Interfaces**
To support our global customer base, many users prefer to use a system that offers native language interface support. In fact, SilverPlatter customers have enjoyed this feature for some time. With the 1.1 release, French, Spanish, and German customers will have the option to view OvidSP in their native language.
- **Additional Enhancements**
Since the release of OvidSP on October 25, 2007, we've been actively monitoring feedback from our customers and are working to turn some of that feedback into developments that will improve user workflow. Recently, remember, we felt it necessary to rename the tabs from "Syntax" to "Advanced".

Much of the feedback that we have received has been in regards to interface and workflow. So in addition to the new features above, the following enhancements will also be included in the early April release:

- After performing a search, the OvidSP screen will remain at the search field rather than "jump" down to the results. While initially our research indicated that our customers would prefer to be brought immediately to their results, subsequent feedback has indicated otherwise.
- Improvements to the Results Manager and the abstracts display.
- Improved functionality of RSS feeds in Internet Explorer 6, which has some known issues with standard RSS feeds.
- Exporting of annotations to EndNote, RefWorks, and other standard citation managers.

On January 20th, PsycEXTRA went live on OvidSP. PsycEXTRA® is a gray literature companion database to PsycINFO. It contains bibliographic and abstract records, as well as full text. In fact, full-text is available for the majority of records (approximately 70%--roughly 600,000 pages—and growing). The database contains publications such as technical and government reports, conference papers, newsletters, magazines, videos, press releases, and consumer brochures.
