

Creating Expert Searches/Filters for your Ovid users: (For Library Administrators):

The Library’s Ovid Site Administrator should contact support@ovid.com and provide the name of the Expert User(s) who will be granted the rights to create, modify or delete Expert Searches.

Ovid Support Department will provide a username and password to be used for this task.

When the Expert User saves a Search strategy, a new option will appear, in the “Saved Searches” drop-down menu:
