Journals on Ovid allow you to read the complete full text of journals you subscribe to as well as offers a variety of article tools such as print, e-mail, save and more.

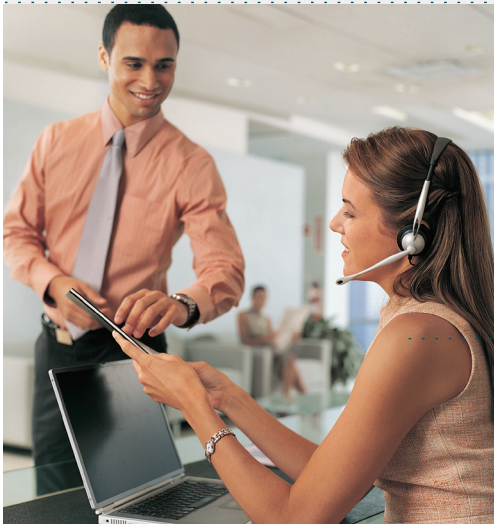
- Navigate directly to relevant sections of an article via the article Outline
